Conference Site and Lodging

The Institute will be held on the campus of NCAR, the National Center for Atmospheric Research on the mesa outside of Boulder, Colorado.



The workshop will provide \$75 per night toward the cost of lodging for participants living more than 30 miles from boulder, Colorado.
